

- (1). Tuesday 28th February 7.30pm - Joe Slattery North Star Family Project Coordinator.
- Joe Slattery is an Experienced Addiction counsellor and coordinator of the NorthStar Family Support Project, a community based project in Limerick, Joe is a specialist indealing with issues of substance abuse with adolescents and their families.
- (2). Tuesday 7th March 7.30pm, Tomi Reichental, Holocaust Survivor. (By Zoom).
- Tomáš Reichental (Tomi) is a Holocaust survivor. He was born in Czechoslovakia in 1935 to Jewish farmers and lived with his family on their farm until he was the age of eight. More than 30 members of his family were killed during the Holocaust.
- (3). Tuesday 14th March 7.30pm - Larry de Cleir, formally Bedford Row Family Project, Limerick.
- Larry de Cléir is a psychotherapist, supervisor and facilitator, and is former Project Leader of Bedford Row Family Project, in Limerick. He has supported families and children affected by imprisonment for over 30 years.
- (4). Tuesday 21st March 7.30pm - Bernárd Lynch.
- Bernard Lynch is an "out" gay Irish born Roman Catholic priest, author, and activist who has worked for the rights of LGBTQIA+ people for almost fifty years. He founded the first AIDS ministry in New York City and was drafted onto the Mayor of New York's Task Force on AIDS.
- (5). Tuesday 28th March 7.30pm-Tom Flynn, Saint Vincent de Paul 'Drop-in Centre' Limerick.
- After working in a number of parishes in Waterford and Tipperary I was appointed a chaplain to the Irish in New York from 1995 – 2022. Was instrumental in opening the Aisling Irish Community Centre in Yonkers 1997. He worked as manager of the Vincent de Paul Drop-In Centre, 2002 – 2023.
