WHO CAN APPLY?

FUNDING AVAILABLE

There are two levels of funding available:

• **Band 1:** Up to £500/€600

Band 2: From £500/€600 to £3,000/€3,500

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications close on Friday, 14th June 2024. Applicants will be required to apply through the MindMatters COI team using the attached form. TRAINING

To be eligible for funding, at least one member of those applying for funding must attend Mental Health Awareness Training. This will be run online from mid-April until mid-June. WHAT TYPE OF INITIATIVES WILL BE FUNDED?

Initiatives should address at least one of the MindMatters Col four themes:

- Reducing stigma
- Promoting connections
- Clergy training and support
- Mental health and faith

You should also note that we will not usually provide financial assistance towards the cost of employees, venue rental, projects already funded via Central Church or towards counselling.
